#### Stay and Learn Sessions

Next half term we will be starting our stay and learn sessions for parents and carers to attend. As before these will be during the last half hour of the school day and will focus on a key aspect of school development. Previous sessions on handwriting, spelling & maths facts (SMIRFS) have provided parents with an insight to how we teach certain aspects of English and Maths as well as offering advice of how to support children at home with their learning.
