Pupil Voice Questionnaires

As part of our on-going school improvement and monitoring, all pupils were recently given the opportunity to feedback on a range of school-wide aspects. We were pleased with their positive comments and thoughts and have already analysed the feedback to identify any objectives going forward. These include:

- > Even more opportunity for children to give ideas in relation to clubs (lunchtime and after-school)
- For the school to increase our education and involvement in 'Green' Eco-friendly campaigns and awareness.
- To further develop outdoor learning opportunities (this is already part of our school improvement plan for this year)

VIPERS Reading Comprehension

Following on from our recent Parent Stay & Learn sessions, a questionnaire was sent out to parents to gain your feedback on your children's views and progress in reading. We have received lots of replies so thank you for these and Mrs Riley, our English Leader, has already begun collating this important feedback. Over the last 2 years we have made significant changes to how we teach English (Reading, Writing, Handwriting and SPAG (Spelling, Punctuation & Grammar) and these have shown significant impact in terms of progress and attainment. VIPERS, our approach to developing the core reading comprehension skills and ensuring that these progress across the whole school, is now embedded practice. Having recently watched a range of English lessons with Mrs Riley, we can see excellent progress in the confidence and enjoyment that children of all ages show during lessons. We will incorporate your feedback within our on-going 'Plan-Do-Review' process.

Breakfast & Afterschool Club Bookings

Please could I remind parents that in order for children to attend breakfast or after school club provision, we need to have your bookings in advance. Booking forms are available from Mrs Johnson at the club or from the school office. We organise our staffing in advance and, unless in the case of a genuine emergency, we can not take last minute bookings. If you have booked a session and your plans have changed meaning you no longer need the provision, we would also appreciate advanced notice of this change as we are, on some occasions, expecting a child to attend after school club but they are then collected which can clearly cause confusion. Thank you for your cooperation.

Information from Public Health England

We have been informed that there has been an earlier increase, from what is expected at this time of year, in people reporting diarrhoea and vomiting illnesses. Public Health England are asking support from parents and schools to ensure that children maintain good hygiene – washing hands with warm soapy water – particularly after using the toilet, using tissues to catch a cough or sneeze and before eating. In addition, children should not attend school when they are experiencing diarrhoea &/or vomiting until 48hrs after the last bout of illness. Thank you for your support.
