Easter Activities

Easter Bonnet Parade

We invite the children in **Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2** to come to school wearing their Easter Bonnets on the last day of term, Friday 3rd April. The children will be parading down the High Street at approximately 9:15am. This is always a popular event and we enjoy seeing the range of different bonnets that children arrive in on the day. All Easter Bonnets should be created at home please. If you would like to come and watch this spectacular event, then you will be more than welcome.

Eggstravaganza (for Year 3 to Year 6)

The KS2 Eggstravaganza will take place on Tuesday 31st March and Wednesday 1st April. This event involves the children creating an 'egg' themed model with an egg-themed title, for example 'Eggsplode'.
