They even showcased their Morris Dancing skills which they have been busy learning as part of their PE Dance unit. 5I showed some inspired learning from their Maths, performing a 'Fractions-themed' song whilst proudly showing a range of other learning from their busy half term.

#### World Book Day

This year we are linking our World Book Day activities to our Arts Focus. *Children do not need to dress up* as we will be having a non-uniform day very soon for Comic Relief Day.

Our focus will instead be on significant illustrators of children's literature – for example, Nick Sharrat who has illustrated books for Jaqueline Wilson and Julia Donaldson. Children will look at and compare examples of illustrations and consider their effect on books before designing their own book illustrations and characters in a similar style.
