Many of you will have read my Facebook update prior to the start of term in relation to our official change of name to Starbeck Primary Academy as we converted on September 1st. We are thrilled to have become part of Northern Star Academies Trust and look forward to playing a key part of a fantastic group of schools all with a shared inclusive and forward-thinking approach to education.

Our staff training days included attending the Northern Star Conference, for all 7 member schools, held at Harrogate High. The focus was on curiosity and staff engaged in a range of innovative and topical workshops.

Open Days

CCTV

Clubs

We will again be offering a range of extra-curricular activities for children to sign up for this year. To start us off we will be holding a Tchukball Club for Years 3 & 4 and Dance Club for Years 5 & 6. Letters have already been sent out giving children the option to sign up. In addition, music/performing arts clubs will also be starting next week including, drama, orchestra, African drumming, choir and more. We will keep you informed of news relating to these clubs as well as other interesting options as the term progresses.

Music Themes

We have a range of new school development focuses this year aimed at further enhancing learning across the school. One new whole school focus which we are introducing straight away, is the introduction of half termly music themes. All children will be introduced to a different genre/style of music from Classical to Pop, Jazz to Country each half term during our music assemblies. This style of music will then be played and discussed in assemblies, and during music lessons to ensure that our children leave school appreciating and understanding the breadth and depth of the world of music. Music is one of, if not the most inclusive subject for all learners and sparks imagination and curiosity. We are starting of with a fab genre – Movie Themes and Soundtracks. This will be introduced next week.
