AUTHORISED ABSENCES

Please could we remind parents and carers to notify school in advance, wherever possible, of any appointments that need to take place during school time. Where possible, appointments should be made outside of school hours – we do however appreciate that hospital appointments and some other medical/specialist sessions are difficult to arrange and we therefore request that you contact the school office team in advance, to notify them of any appointments during school hours. When collecting any child early (via the school office), you will be asked to complete a short form giving the reason for early collection.

We would also like to remind parents of the national rules relating to requests for leave of absence during term time. Authorised absence can only be granted where there are exceptional circumstances (examples of these can be found on the request form). If you need to request leave of absence for your child, you must complete a form 6 weeks in advance of the leave taking place wherever possible. These can be obtained by speaking to our admin team at the school office. Holidays during term-time are unlikely to be classified as an 'exceptional circumstance'. Please note that unauthorised absence can result in a penalty notice being issued by North Yorkshire Council. Thank you for you cooperation.
