The survey showed no signs of RAC in any NSAT school, including Starbeck. Our school was also built well before the 1950 – 1990 dates when RAC was used as a material in buildings. Our business managers have followed these surveys up with calls to discuss the surveys in detail.

We are therefore in a good place to begin our new term without concerns about the impact of such materials on school environments and knowing that our school is not affected by this national concern.
